Nursery Tour & Propagation Demonstration

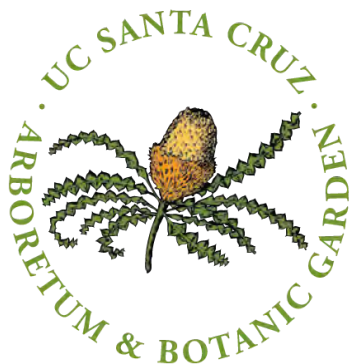
